Estates and Parliamentary Committee 21 June 1834 (909) Tenancy for land at Edge Lane and Lodge Fold Farm approved for another 5 years.

Estates and Parliamentary Committee 19 July 1934 (916)
Tenancy no.3, Lodge Fold, Higher Cloughfold
...adverted to minute 867 giving notice to terminate...the tenant...had not yet removed. The Committee...having regard to the decision to take down the buildings and to erect an electricity substation etc on the site thereof...resolved...to take the necessary steps for eviction.

Highway and Sewerage Committee 22 Nov 1934 (1723) Proposed Telephone kiosk

The borough surveyor submitted applications from the Post Office Telecommunications Department for permission to erect a public telephone kiosk at each of the following places, namely, (a) Burnley Road Waterfoot opposite Globe works, (b) Newchurch Road Higher Cloughfold and (c) Church Street Newchurch and it was Resolved That such applications be approved.

Estates and Parliamentary Committee 20 Dec 1934 (944)
The departments of transport, electricity and health were each charged £2.5.0/year ground rent for bus shelter, substation and WC at Higher Cloughfold respectively.

Housing committee 7 Jan 1935 (1325) Land at Higher Cloughfold

The town clerk submitted a letter of the 26th ultimo from Mr B Death asking to be released from the agreement for tenancy of the plot of land behind the Cloughfold Housing Site, and the Committee, after considering the matter, Resolved – that the application be granted and that the tenancy be determined as from the 31st ultimo.
