

## ROSSENDALE

Rossendale is an important manufacturing district, including Rawtenstall, Crawshaw Booth, Newchurch, Stacksteads and other villages and hamlets. It was originally an extensive forest, but in the reign of Henry VIII it was disforested, when the population at that time, is said to have been only 80. Its progress and prosperity is due to the manufactures of woollen and cotton goods, which are extensively carried on. Water is plentiful, and stone and coal of good quality are worked. In the district are mills for the manufacture of carpets, felts, &c.: engineering works, saw mills, &c. The river Irwell flows through the whole length of the district. The Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway have stations at Rawtenstall, Cloughfold, Newchurch, and Stacksteads. To meet the increasing demands of the district, the line is being widened. The system of co-operation has good support here, many large mills, and stores for the sale of grocery, provisions &c., being worked on that principle. The Duke of Buccleugh is Lord of the Manor. The population in 1871 was 14,419.

Rawtenstall is a prosperous village, two miles from Haslingden, four from Bacup and seven from Burnley, Union of Haslingden and Hundred of Blackburn, is also a polling place for the north-east division of the county. The Co-operative Hall, used for public meetings, &c., can accommodate 1,500 people. There is also an Exchange and newsroom, recently erected on the Newchurch Road. The Church of St Mary was erected in 1837 by public subscription. The site was given by the late Henry Hoyle Esq., who also endowed it with the interest of £1,000. The living is a vicarage. There is a chapel of ease at Cloughfold, dedicated to St John. The Rev. James Norris, B.A., is the vicar. The population of the ecclesiastical district in 1871 was 8,644. The Wesleyan Chapel is a commodious structure, built in 1842. The Methodist Free Church on Haslingden road, erected in 1857, is a magnificent edifice in the Corinthian style of architecture. The cost was £6 There are seats for 1,000 people.,000, inclusive of schools, the expense being borne by David and Peter Whitehead, Esqrs. There are seats for 1,000 people. The Roman Catholics, Baptists, Unitarians, and Primitive Methodists have chapels here.

Crawshaw Booth is a village about a mile-and-a-half from Rawtenstall, on the Burnley road in the township of Higher Booths. The cotton trade is largely carried on. All Saints' Church, Goodshaw Booth, the present edifice, was erected in 1829; but there has been a church here for upwards of three centuries. The living is a vicarage, annual value £300, with residence, in the gift of Hulme's trustees, held by the Rev. J. Howard. The population of the ecclesiastical district in 1871 was 5,095. There is a Wesleyan Chapel, capable of seating 1,000 worshippers. The Baptists have chapels at Sunnyside and Goodshaw, the Primitive Methodists at Crawshaw Booth; and a Friends' Meeting House.

Lumb, is an ecclesiastical district in the parish of Whalley, about two miles from Newchurch. The Church is dedicated to St Michael. The Rev. Robert Alexander McKee, M.A., Lumb, is the vicar. The patronage is vested in the Crown and Bishop of Manchester alternately. Population of

the district 2,760. Newchurch, a manufacturing district, about two-and-a-half miles from Bacup, and three-and-a-half from Haslingden. The population of the township which includes Bacup, in 1871, was 26,823. The Church of St Nicholas is a neat edifice. The embattled tower contains a peal of six bells. The living is a rectory of the annual value of £580, in the gift of the Vicar of Whalley. The Rev. J. B. Phillips, M.A., is the Rector. The population of the Ecclesiastical district is 7,097. The Grammar school was erected and endowed by John Kershaw of Wolfenden, in 1711. The endowment amounts to about £50 per annum. St James' Church at Waterfoot is a handsome building, erected in 1863. In 1873 a spire 60 feet high was added to the tower in which are a peal of six bells. The living is a vicarage, held by the Rev A. J. Harrison, D.D., and in the patronage of the trustees. The Wesleyans, Baptists, Primitive Methodists, and Unitarians, have places of worship in the district.

Stacksteads, a mile from Bacup, is a station on the Lancashire Railway. Cotton and woollen goods are largely manufactured. It forms an ecclesiastical district with Tunstead. The Church is dedicated to the Holy Trinity, and was built in 1840. The Rev John G. Haworth is the incumbent. There are extensive co-operative stores, with newsrooms attached, well supplied with daily, weekly, and illustrated papers. The Wesleyans, Baptists and Primitive Methodists have chapels here. The population of the ecclesiastical district is 6,325.
